

► Five Plus Bingo.

Children have playing boards as shown below and some counters. The teacher or leader rolls a cube with numerals 0, 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and calls out the number that is face-up. A traditional die can be used with the teacher calling out 0 when the 6 is thrown. Students add this number to five and place a counter on one of the squares containing this number. The aim is to get four (or five) counters in a row.
